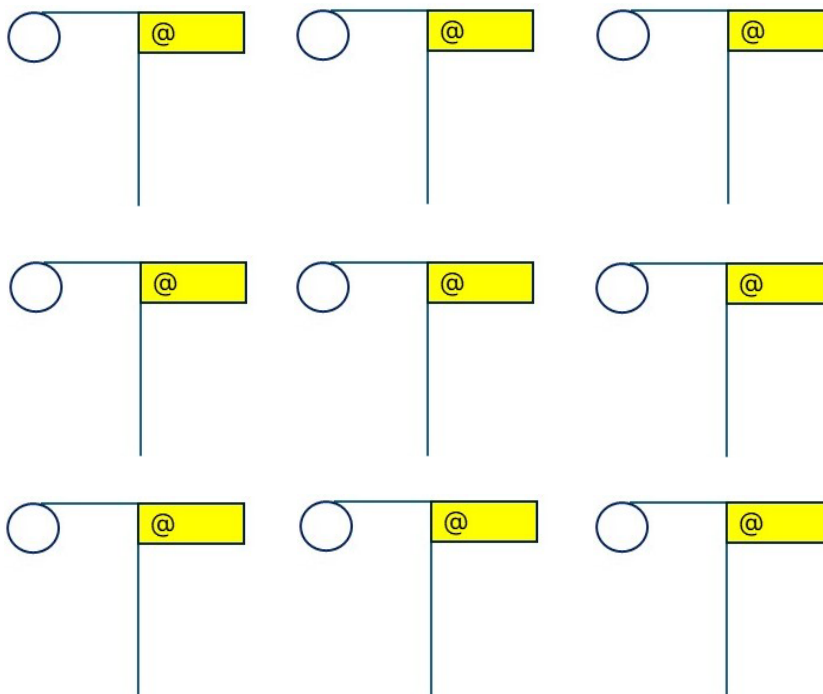

Immediately acknowledge Mayday: **WHO / WHAT / WHERE / AIR?**

- GRAB LIVES**

 - Air @ time _____
 - Air @ time _____
 - Air @ time _____
 - Air @ time _____
 - Radio: coach with channel/knob orientation, monitor other channels
 - Activate PASS if necessary
 - Breathing: Hum or Box Breathing
 - Stay Low – drop to belly
 - Shine flashlight up or wave it
 - Make noise
 - Try to find an exit (window/door)

- Request Emergency Traffic & channel markers.
Add a 2nd Alarm
 -
- Announce:**
*“All units on the fireground:
 We have a Mayday in progress.
 Maintain radio discipline.
 Do not self-deploy.”*

Determine “Needs” to solve Mayday
 Tactical Considerations

- Positive Coaching**
*“Control/slow your breathing”
 “Stay calm, you got this”
 “You’re doing great”
 “Help is on the way”*

Shelter in Place
 Connect UAC hose
 Use TIC to find landmarks
 Pre-package: waist strap between legs
 Hug the hoseline

Running/Out of Air
 Prepare hood to place over face piece
 Suck the floor – stay low as possible
 Find a vent or fresh air opening

- Establish Division/Rescue Group
- Control entry/exit points
- Deploy On-Deck if necessary
- Backfill On-Deck
- Balance to 2nd Alarm
- Keep lines on the fire
- Additional handlines to area
- Soften Building

- Ventilation
- Lighting
- Deploy medic unit to immediate area
- Add +1 Engine to support Medical
- Place helicopter on standby
- Cyanokit in BN203
- Prepare for additional Maydays
